

## **Title II**

### **Annual Report for FY06**

Scottsboro City Schools hired two teachers as class-size reduction units for FY06. One teacher taught seventh grade social studies at Scottsboro Junior High School, and another teacher taught 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade English at Scottsboro High School. These units reduced class-sizes significantly in these grade levels.

The addition of these units had an impact on the academic proficiency of these students. The 7<sup>th</sup> grade students scores 63% in History and 49% in social studies on the SAT-10. These are both above the national average. The 10<sup>th</sup> grade students at Scottsboro High School had an increase of proficiency on the Alabama Direct Assessment of Writing and an improved on the reading scores on the Alabama High School Graduation Exam. Language scores stayed the same.

The addition of the two class-size reduction units has had an impact on the academic progress for students at Scottsboro High School and Scottsboro Junior High.
